

## Year 7 Catch up 2015/16

(Correct at February 2016)

**Catch up is what the school is doing for the pupils who did not get a level 4 in their KS 2 SAT tests.**

### **Finance**

14/15 £16000 was received

15/16 approximately £8000 will be received

### **Interventions and teaching over the last 2 years**

Maths intervention officer is currently weekly with individual and small groups.

Maths HLTA targeted intervention and support in Maths lessons.

English HLTA targeted intervention and support.

Smaller class sizes for weekly Maths and English lessons for catch up year 7 set.

North Tyneside Learning Trust used for one half day a week in spring and summer term.

All staff in school have now received inference training. (January 2015)

### **Current impact of 14/15 money (pupils now in year 8)**

3 pupils from this cohort have now left the school

**MATHS** - 71% of pupils have now moved to level 4 and beyond

**READING** – All pupils have now moved top level 4 and beyond

**WRITING**- All pupils have now moved to level 4 and beyond

## **Impact by the end of January on the current year 7 cohort**

### **MATHS**

60% pupils who did not get their level 4 SAT result are now working at Level 4 or beyond.

### **READING**

ALL pupils who did not get their Level 4 SAT result have now reached level 4 or moved to level 5

### **WRITING**

All pupils who did not get their level 4 are have now produced work that is in line with national expectations of last summer to merit level 4 being awarded.
