Year 7 Catch up 2016/17

(Correct at May 2017)

Catch up is what the school is doing for the pupils who did not meet the expected national standard in the SAT test at the end of Year 6.

Finance

Interventions and teaching over the last 2 years

- Maths HLTA targeted intervention and support in Maths lessons.
- English HLTA targeted intervention and support for Year 7 pupils not meeting the standard in Year 6
- An additional LSA has been employed on a part time basis for English
- Smaller class sizes for weekly Maths and English lessons for catch up year 7 set.
- North Tyneside Learning Trust used for one half day a week in Autumn term for maths
- All staff in school have now received inference training.

Current impact on Year 7 cohort

MATHS - 32 pupils did not make the standard during the SAT test. 8 pupils have now left the school, of the remaining pupils, 15 have now caught up (63%) with their peers. All of the pupils (100%) have made progress from their SATS test score.

READING - 39 pupils did not make the standard during the SATS test. 8 pupils have now left the school, of the pupil's remaining 27 have now caught up (87%) with their peers. All of the pupils (100%) have made progress from their SATS test score.

WRITING - 19 pupils did not make the standard during Year 6. 47% (9) of these pupils have now caught up. All of the pupils (100%) have made progress from there attainment point in Year 6.
