This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purposes of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Student entitlement

Students in year 8 are entitled:

- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships through assemblies, target group and whole class/year group sessions.
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

Although the entitlement is officially from year 8, as a middle school we have made the decision to include all year groups in our CEIAG provision to enable them to have early access to this valuable information.
