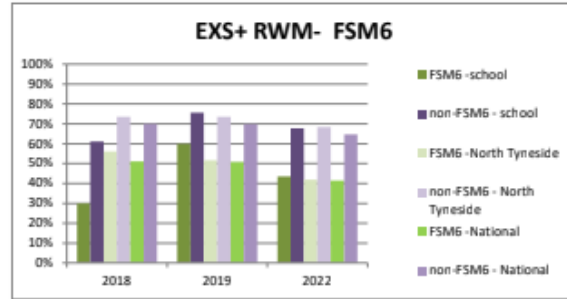
2022 Results:

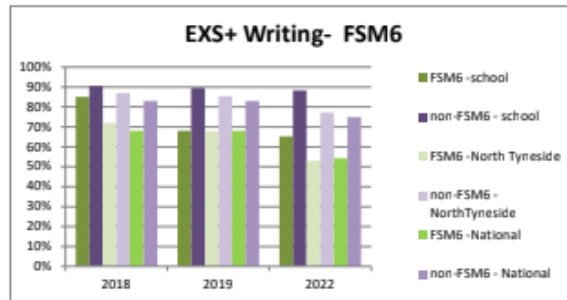

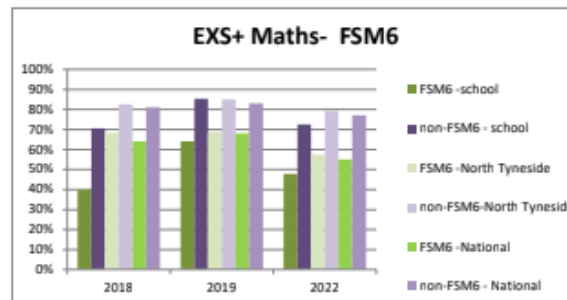
