



Pupil Premium Summary Statement for 2015/16

In 2015/16 Marden Bridge Middle School received £139,875 in Pupil Premium funding, and we have effectively utilised this to secure improved outcomes for our **disadvantaged pupils**:

At Key Stage 2:

| Disadvantaged pupils Attainment | National | MBMS |

In the KS2 SAT results, MBMS disadvantaged pupils performed **significantly better than their peers nationally**.
