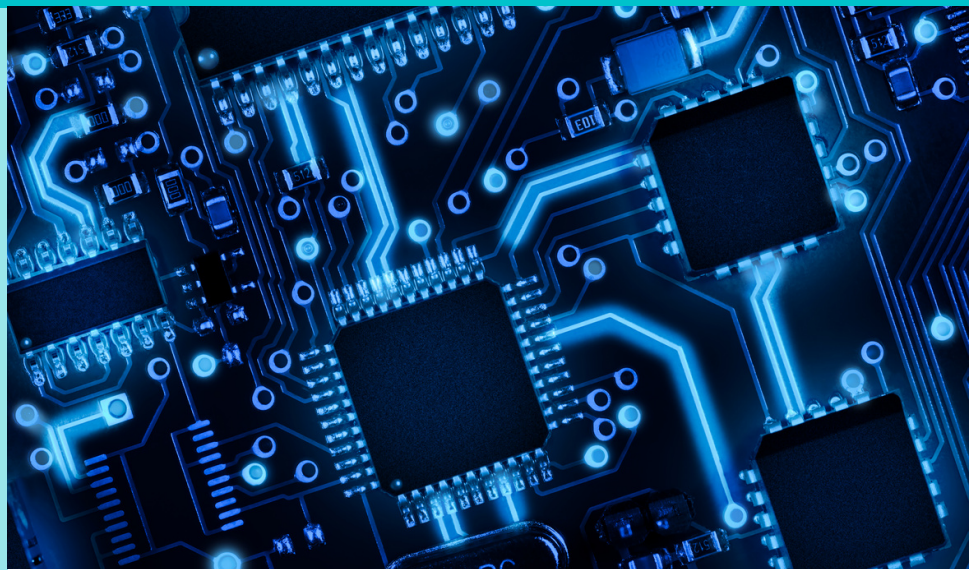

Week 2: Gaming Week

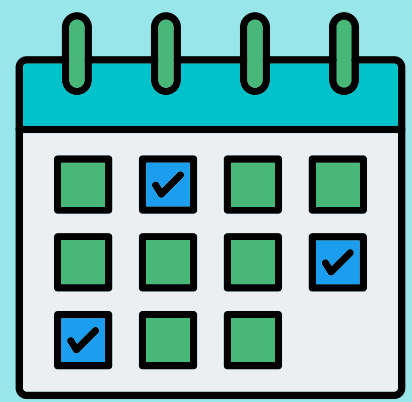
A great week for students to understand the skills they use in gaming and the exciting career opportunities in this industry. Stay tuned for our gaming resources, competition, and blog.

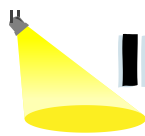

INDUSTRY HIGHLIGHT

In this month's newsletter, we are highlighting the career of a UX Designer. A career in an industry of rapid growth, with more demand year by year.

UX designers have a huge impact on the introduction of new products and services and on innovation.

UX DESIGNER

User experience (UX) designers work on making sure applications and websites are enjoyable and easy to use for individual users. They are involved in the design of digital products and services, such as apps and websites, for specific target groups and users. In this role, you'll perform several tasks including sketching concepts, redesigning websites, creating mobile apps, and creating prototypes.

The technology industry is booming in the North East and is home to software and technology companies operating across the globe. The industry is growing and there is a constant need for skilled and talented individuals, so there is ample opportunity in the region to excel as a UX designer.

Some skills that would help in a role such as a UX designer would include communication, computer literacy, flexibility and adaptability, design, and spatial awareness. Whether you are working on your own, or as part of a team, you need to be able to gauge how usable a website is and adapt it where necessary.
